The methodology for including particular incident types (member involved shootings, pellet/bb guns/simunition, self-inflicted/accidental, animal related calls, and/or where the location incident is unconfirmed, but believed to be outside Surrey, etc), as well as CCJS/ UCR scoring and Calls For Service types have evolved over the years and collection methodology may not be consistent year to year over this ten year period
